**Start Those Seeds** **March 26<sup>th</sup> or 28<sup>th</sup>**

With the start of spring, we'll talk about ways that we can prepare our gardens and even start some of our own vegetable seeds indoors.

**Tracking** **April 2<sup>nd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup>**

With the help of our classmates and animals around the farm, this week we'll explore how tracks are made and identify their differences. We'll explore the farm together to find tracks and see where they lead us!

**Caterpillars** **April 9<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup>**

With our classmates, we'll discuss beneficial and not-so-beneficial, caterpillars and the life cycle of butterflies and moths. We'll prepare our own habitat for painted lady caterpillars to watch them transform throughout the semester.

**Tadpoles to Frogs** **April 16<sup>th</sup> or 18<sup>th</sup>**

This week we'll learn about the life cycle of frogs, from egg to adult. We'll search for eggs and tadpoles around the farm and observe some together in class.

**All About Erosion** **April 23<sup>rd</sup> or 25<sup>th</sup>**

Through different experiments, we'll learn how water, wind and rocks can change the landscape around us and different things that help hold soil in place.



**Buzzing Bees** **April 30<sup>th</sup> or May 2<sup>nd</sup>**

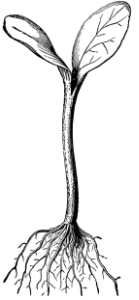
This week we'll learn what all the buzz about bees is! We'll discuss how these fuzzy insects live, how they benefit humans and ways that we can help them thrive!

**Beautiful Butterflies** **May 7<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup>**

We'll check back in with our transforming caterpillars this week to discuss how they've grown and changed throughout the semester. After observing them, we'll learn about ways that butterflies benefit the farm and prepare those that are ready to be released!

Now that we've watched our plants grow in class throughout the semester, we'll discuss how they've changed and prepare them to bring home to our gardens.

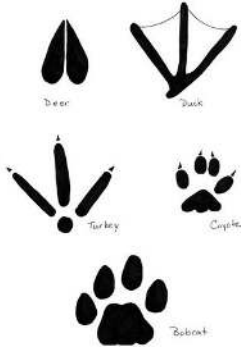
