Forest Introductions

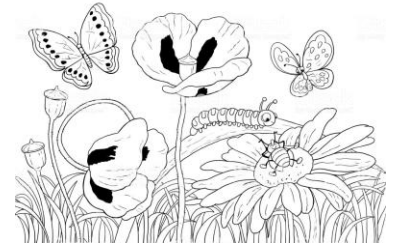
September 17th or 19th

Take a hike and become acquainted with nature, the plants and animals of Fernbrook's forest ecosystem, and our new classmates. The students will learn each other's names while we collect sticks and other materials for our nature craft

Buggin' Out in the Meadow

September 24th or 26th

Discover bugs and insects in an exciting exploration of our meadow ecosystem. The students will use nets or their bare hands to catch friendly critters and identify their features while we share our findings with our friends.



Where Does My Trash Go?

October 1st or 3rd

Learn about where we put our trash, recycling and food scraps on the farm and how you can help create less waste at home. We'll take a trip around the farm to help clean up while we learn the difference between our trash and recycle bins. We will end with a trip to the pigs to feed them our food scraps and discuss how these actions help keep our farm sustainable and our environment cleaner.

Colors and Shapes of Fall

October 8th or 10th

Search for signs of fall on the farm while we identify the many different shapes and colors of nature. The children will collect their favorite leaves to decorate the classroom to match the beauty of autumn outside.

Sun & Shadows

October 15th or 17th

How does the sun's position in the sky create the shadows we see on the Earth? With *Moonbear's Shadow* by Frank Asch as our backdrop this week, we will find shadows around the farm and participate in a hands-on science activity to discover how shadows are made and how they change throughout the day.

Bird Migrations

October 22nd or 24th

Grab your binoculars as we head out on the farm to watch the birds as they make their way south for the winter. The classes will learn about what birds need in order to survive and why they need to move with the seasons to find these necessities throughout the year.



Pumpkins, Squashes & Gourds, OH MY!

October 29th or 31st

Take a stroll through our CSA fields and see what kind of fresh goodies our farmers are harvesting this time of year. We will discuss what crops we find in autumn and how they can be used for food and other fall fun as we make our own pumpkin art.

Earth ROCKS!

November 5th or 7th

Together our class will investigate the different sizes, shapes, and textures of the rocks we collect on our farm. As we sort our findings, we will learn about what's below the Earth's surface and the story of how these rocks came to be.

*** Please note that the class topics for the Pre-K and Kindergarten classes are the same, but the content will be altered to fit the learning abilities of the different age groups. FFEEC is dedicated to providing age appropriate learning experiences for all children as they explore their natural world.***

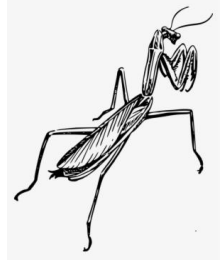
