

#### Our World Through a Magnifier December 3<sup>rd</sup> or 5<sup>th</sup>

The students will get up close and personal with the world around them this week, as we learn how to use a magnifying lens. With our magnifiers as our tools we will take a hike to investigate what details we can learn about nature when we pause and look closely.



#### Animal Tracks December 10th or 12th

Become a detective in this class as we learn about the different shapes and sizes of the tracks animals leave behind. We will identify the tracks we spot on the farm and use our imaginations to come up with the animals' stories – Where were they going? What were they doing?

#### **Everlasting Evergreens**

December 17th or 19th

As Winter approaches and the fall leaves have dropped, our class will explore Fernbrook's assortment of evergreen trees, from pines to

spruces. How do these trees look, feel, and smell different than the other trees around the farm? Students will use their senses to discover the answers to these and other questions during this all hands-on lesson.
