Numbers in Nature September 15th/17th


It's time to get outside! This week we will take advantage of the endless opportunities to count, sort, and find patterns in nature.

Land Art September 22nd/24th

Building on our recognition of patterns and numbers from last week, students will create their own masterpieces with the natural materials they find.

<u>Creek Splashing</u> Sept. 29th/Oct. 1st

During this class our little explorers will take a hike down to Fernbrook's creek to explore this unique and diverse ecosystem. *Come prepared to get wet and muddy! *water shoes or old sneakers are best! Boots fill with water and become hard to walk in*



Insect Safari

October 6th/8th

During this class the students will go on a guided insect safari where we will explore the meadow on a search for Fernbrook's most interesting critters. The class will participate in activities that teach us about bug basics, insect eyes and their habitat.

Wiggling Worms

October 13th/15th

Get up-close and personal with our squiggly, wiggly friends this week as we learn about worms and how they play an important role in the health

of our soil.

All about Birds October 20th/22nd

Its spring time, which means you will hear lots of different nature sounds outside. A major spring sound is the many types of birds chirping. Come learn all about birds and how they are characterized by their many variations of feathers, beaks and eggs.

Nuts for Acorns! October 27th/29th

Acorns are an essential food for many of our animal friends during the fall season. Together the students will learn about these tree nuts. Through experiential explorations the class will discover how they grow into giant oaks and what types of animals depend on them as a vital source of food.



Home Sweet Home November 3rd/5th

The students will visit and see different habitats and figure out what animals look for when creating a home such as food, water, shelter, and space. We'll discover that forests, wetlands, and grasslands are unique and separate habitats. The children will then design a habitat that they would like to live in.

** Please note that the class topics for the Pre-K and Kindergarten classes are the same, but the content will be altered to fit the learning abilities of the different age groups. FFEEC is dedicated to providing age appropriate learning experiences for all children as they explore their natural world.*

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
