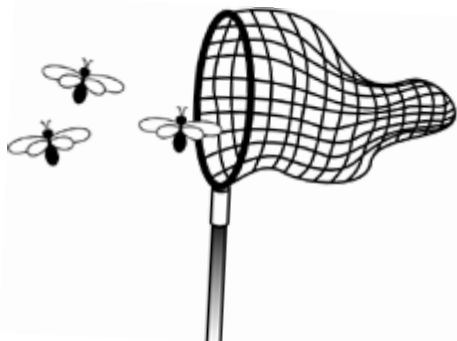
**September 22<sup>nd</sup>/24<sup>th</sup>**

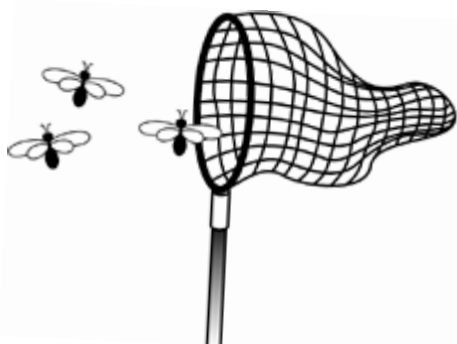
