
Spring Weather March 23rd or 25th

Rain, wind, hail, sun, and temperature affect a farmer's day.

Throughout our class the students will learn the importance of keeping track of the weather on the farm and how to look at nature for clues to weather changes.

Goats at Fernbrook March 30th or April 1st

How does a goat's running, jumping, and climbing ability compare to the other "kids"? The students will meet our goat herd to engage with them, as well as learn some fun facts about their breed and purpose.



Roots and Stems April 6th or 8th

Plants with leaves and flowers attract our attention, but most plants also have roots and stems. Our classes will see what they look like big and small. Students will also understand what helps plants to grow.

Our Sense of Sight April 13th or 15th

Observation is an important part of connecting with nature and science. Students will test their sense of sight and learn about the vision of other animals as we go on a nature scavenger hunt.

<u>Light and Color</u> <u>April 20th or 22nd</u>

Springtime means more light and color outside. Our classes will explore the properties of reflection and refraction with fun light science experiments.

Spiders, Spiders Everywhere April 27th or 29th

We can find spiders and their webs indoors and out. As we learn about their physical characteristics and behaviors the students will learn how spiders help us to survive.

Feathers May 4th or 6th

Whether for flying, protection, or showing off, different feathers have different jobs. During this class, the students will take a closer look at these unique features of birds.

What Floats? May 11th or 13th

Water quality depends on many different properties. Our students will study water and its properties through fun experiments to see how it is affected by other substances and environmental conditions.

** Please note that the class topics for the Pre-K and Kindergarten classes are the same, but the content will be altered to fit the learning abilities of the different age groups.
