March 23rd or 25th

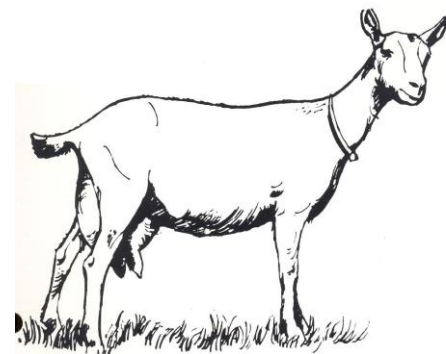
Rain, wind, hail, sun, and temperature affect a farmer's day.
