Metamorphic Magic

September 20th or 22nd

Let's learn a new word...METAMORPHOSIS!!!! As the class explores the meadow and farm fields searching for signs of butterflies, caterpillars, bees, and grasshoppers the students will solve the mystery of their unique life cycle!

Growing Green

September 27th or 29th

Trees, grasses, wildflowers, bushes, vegetables give us a lush and green environment to navigate as students venture through our meadow, forest, and farm fields of Fernbrook Farms. Identifying what makes plants green, what flowers, what is living and non-living, and where seeds come from are just some of the questions the class will analyze.

What makes an Insect an Insect?

October 4th or 6th

Insects live in so many unique environments! Students will evaluate the characteristics that a true insect has, including their unique body functions. Ever wonder how insects breathe? What is an exoskeleton? How do they adapt to their changing habitats? The students will grab their magnifying lenses to answer these mysterious questions!

Water Works!!

October 11th or 13th

This aquatic ecological adventure will explore the study of all living and nonliving things within Fernbrook's aquatic ecosystems. Students should be prepared to get a little wet and muddy as they search for amphibians, aquatic insects, macroinvertebrates, and aquatic plants at our pond and/or creek.

Maple Tree Madness

October 18th or 20th

Did you know there are 12 species of maple trees found in North America?! The students will see what is growing at Fernbrook by observing a variety of maple leaves as well as the structure of maple trees. Students may also create some leaf art using all parts collected from the maple trees.

Barnyard Round-up

October 25th or 27th

Let's take a visit to the animal barn and figure out what types of food webs occur in this niche habitat. Students will then explore a natural habitat and create their own food web.

Changing of the Seasons

November 1st or 3rd

Weather is a driving force for the changing of the seasons. Let's delve into the weather around us as we are in the height of New Jersey's fall season. Students will observe the cloud shapes, how to "read" the sky to tell if its going to rain, and how weather affects our earth.

Geology: Rocks!!!

November 8th or 10th

Sedimentary, metamorphic, and igneous rocks are all around us in different shapes and sizes. Students will collect and explore the different forms around Fernbrook Farms.
