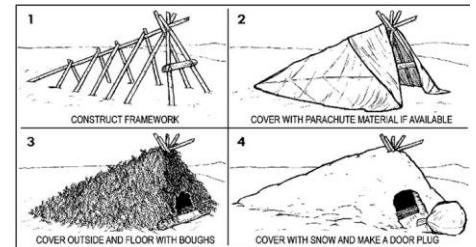

“Wilderness Survival Skills”

Fernbrook Farms Environmental Education Center's Lower Level Homeschool Program provides students with an alternative way of learning. Students spend a day once a week on our 230 acre working farm with amazing natural resources such as 60 acres of forest, a meadow, streams, agriculture, and a rich history. Our dedicated staff work with small groups of students to provide hands-on learning experiences.

Our Bridge Program is a short period of classes between our 8-week semesters and is a great way to bridge the gap between our Fall and Winter Semesters, as well as try out our classes to see if you are interested in pursuing participation in our future programs. Survival Basic Needs- Fire, Water, Shelter

November 29th, 30th, December 1st, 2nd

This first class will introduce the students to the basics of surviving in the wilderness. Basic survival needs are fire, water, and shelter. Having the proper skills to find supplies to build a fire and sustain a fire will be practiced. Students will also understand the importance of packing enough water for a hiking adventures as well as learning how to properly filter from freshwater sources. Lastly, the students will work together to build a survival shelter to accommodate 1 to 2 people during a winter adventure gone wrong, and most importantly understand why PMA (personal mental attitude) is so important in a survival situation.



What If Scenarios: Backcountry First Aid

December 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th

Knowledge of basic first aid skills is absolutely a necessity when camping, backpacking, or spending anytime out in the wilderness. During this class students will decide what is essential in a wilderness first aid kit. Students will work together to solve real-life scenarios such as consuming contaminated water, snake bites, poisonous plants, and sprains/strains to arms and legs.

Hittin' the Trail & Setting up Camp

December 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th

As the class “Hits the Trail” the students will determine what supplies we must gather in our packs. We will discuss proper foot care, personal energy conservation, and the importance of planning a route and knowing the terrain. The students will pack up some packs and hit the Fernbrook trails! Ending class by building a fire, practicing setting up a basic tent and have a special treat!
