Animal Tracks **November 28th or 30th**

Become a detective in this class as students learn about the different shapes and sizes of the tracks animals leave behind. As a class we will identify the tracks we spot around the farm and use our imaginations to come up with the animals' stories – Where were they going? What were they doing? Students will also create their own animal track craft to take home.

Animals & Insects in Winter **December 5th or 7th**

Students will explore the forest to find out what animals and insects do in the winter. Classes will learn about hibernation and migration. We'll problem solve which animals and insects migrate, which ones hibernate, and which ones stay active in the cold weather!



Holiday Gifts from Nature **December 12th or 14th**

The final class the students will discuss holiday traditions from our homes and around the world. The students will work together on their letters, numbers, and fine motor skills to create gifts from nature for our friends and family to share throughout the season!
