It is a covenant between the farmers and the members of the community in a relationship that benefits both sides. People purchase a share to the farm before the farm season. Then during the season, members get a weekly distribution from the farm of fresh, chemical-free produce, fruits, flowers, and herbs. This system allows the farmer to mitigate some risks by having a known number of customers and income which also helps immensely in the crop planning and marketing aspects of the farm. And the individuals and families who join get healthy, delicious, nutrient-filled food!
